Frequently Asked Questions

MOA June 2017 for Hannigan/Jacobs Elementary School

- 1. Q: What happens if we don't get the grant?
 - A. This agreement becomes null and void.
- 2. Q: How does this MOA effect the general contract?
 - A. The current contract language prevails unless otherwise amended in the MOA.
- 3. Q: What happens if we don't receive the full grant?
 - A. If the district does not get the full grant, the district and association will negotiate the new parameters.
- 4. Q: What will be the length of my new work day?
 - A. Your day will be one hour longer.
- 5. Q: What will be the length of the student instructional day?
 - A. The length of the student day will be one hour longer.
- 6. Q: What will be the amount of my compensation for this extended time?
 - A. \$5,200
- 7. Q: Will this monetary stipend count towards retirement?
 - A. Yes.
- 8. Q: How will I receive this money?
 - A. It will be paid weekly for 42 weeks.
- 9. Q: What will happen with the 21st Century Program?
 - A. It will start one hour later.
- 10.Q: Will there still be after school meetings?
 - A. Yes, but the number of hours have been reduced from 12 hours to 8 hours.

11.Q: Currently I have 10 preparation periods per week. Will I continue to do so?

A. Yes, you will continue to have it from 7:30-8:10 as well as a planning period during the student instructional day as is the current practice.

12.Q: I am a related service provider who currently receives five individual preps per five-day week. Will I continue to do so?

A. Yes

13.Q: If I choose not to stay in this school, may I Opt Out?

A. Yes

14.Q: Do I need to have PTS to Opt Out?

A. No, anyone will be able to Opt Out and still be guaranteed a job.

15.Q: What if there are no positions I am interested in at this time?

A. You would be able to declare yourself an involuntary transferee for the 2018-19 school year and you would be guaranteed a position at another school the following school year.

16.Q: What happens when the Grant runs out?

A. The MOA ceases to exist unless both parties agree to continue.
