Side Letter of Agreement

And

The New Bedford Educators Association Units A and B

WHEREAS, the New Bedford Public Schools ("District") and the U.S. Department of Justice are parties to a settlement agreement dated September 15, 2022 (hereinafter referred to as "the DOJ Agreement") related to English Language Learners in the District;

WHEREAS, on September 26, 2022, the New Bedford Educators Association Unit A and Unit B ("Union" or "NBEA") and District representatives engaged in bargaining over the impacts of the DOJ Agreement as such relate to employees represented by the Union; and

WHEREAS, the District and the Union wish to memorialize their understanding of their negotiations on September 26, 2022;

NOW THEREFORE, the District and the Union agree as follows:

- 1. All training of employees represented by the Union that is required by the DOJ Agreement will occur during the work day for such employees.
- 2. Nothing in the DOJ Agreement replaces Appendix D of the NBEA Unit A collective bargaining agreement between the Union and the New Bedford School Committee.
- 3. The New Bedford School Committee/District has satisfied its bargaining obligations with the Union with respect to the actions it is required to take pursuant to the DOJ Agreement.
- 4. This Side Letter of Agreement shall remain in effect for as long as the DOJ Agreement is in effect.
